- average 5.2 °C



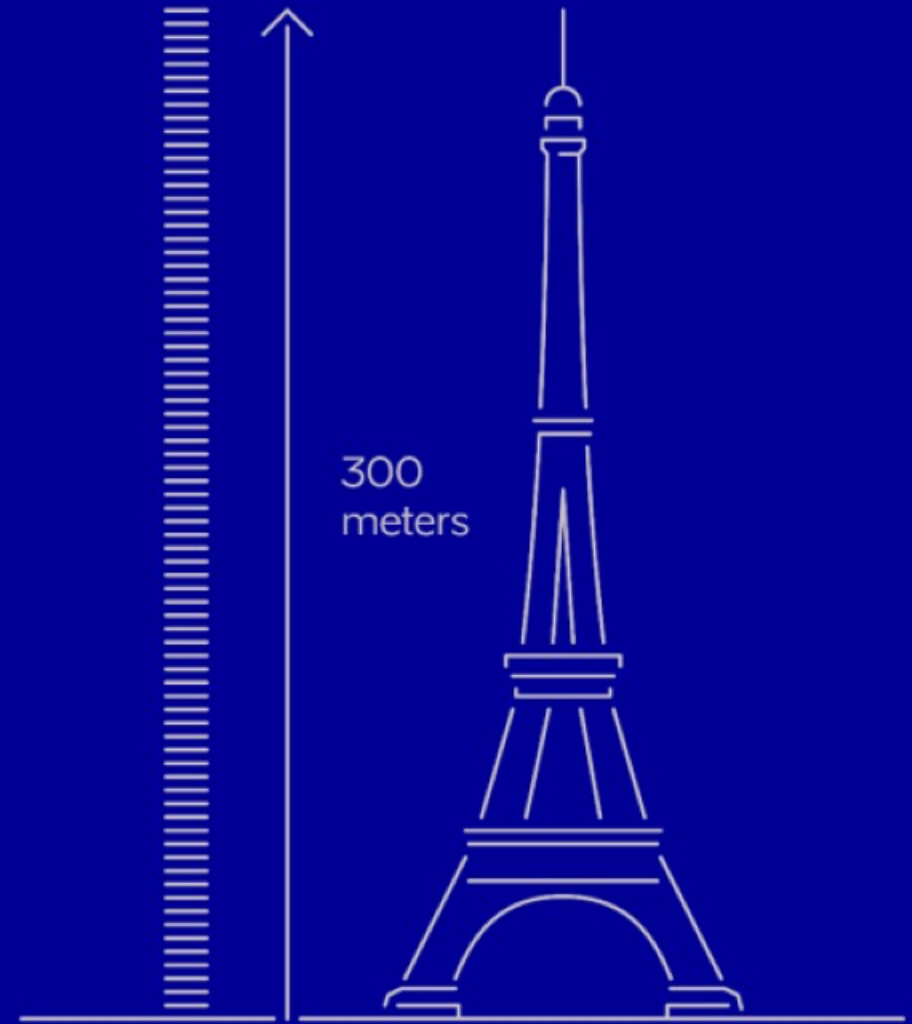

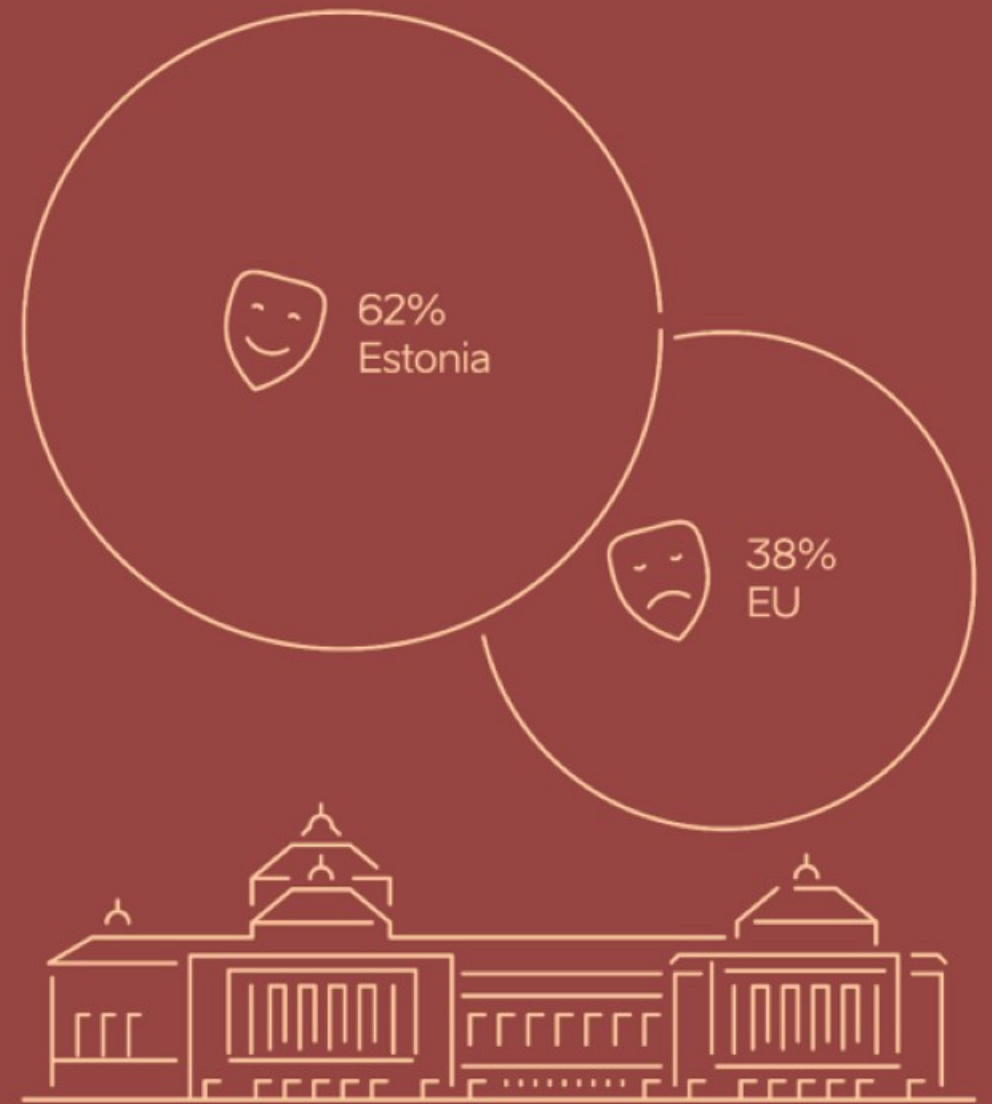
